INTO FAMILY VIOLENCE**

Earlier this year the Commissioners delivered their report to Government House in Victoria, the culmination of a thirteen month inquiry.

The Commission was tasked with making recommendations that will influence generational change to prevent and respond to family violence, including making perpetrators accountable, improving early intervention and supporting victims.

Prior to the Royal Commission, The Honourable Marcia Neave was a judge of the Court of Appeal in the Supreme Court of Victoria, a former chair of the Victorian Law Reform Commission, and has also enjoyed an extensive career as a legal academic and public policy maker. With her enduring interest in the way the law responds to the needs of women, we believe Ms Neave has a vitally important message to deliver for the White Ribbon Campaign in South Australia.
